Varies greatly, but renowned for velvety texture and complex palate with dark fruits and spice.

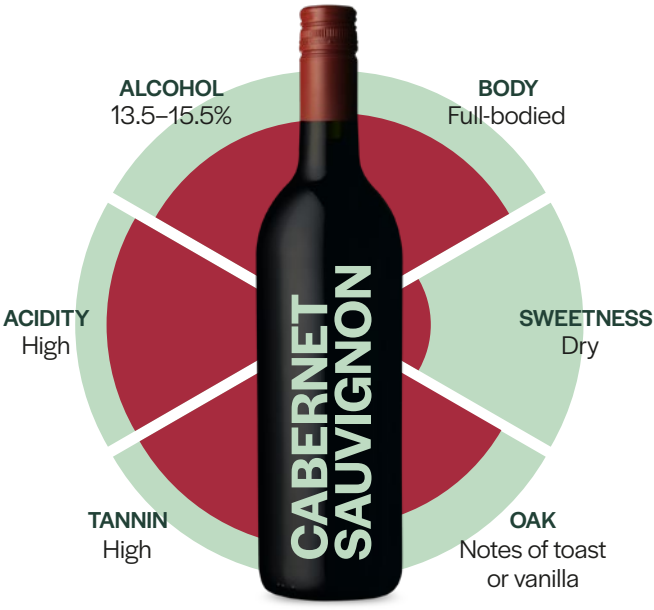

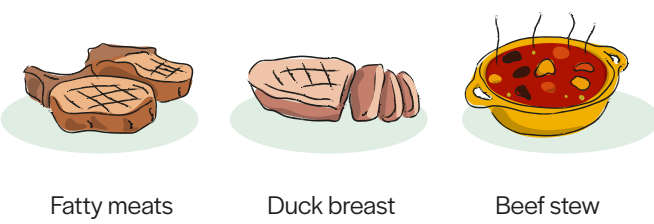


Cabernet Sauvignon

Vermentino

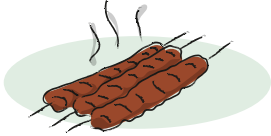
Medium-bodied white

Tempranillo

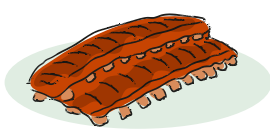
Medium-bodied red
