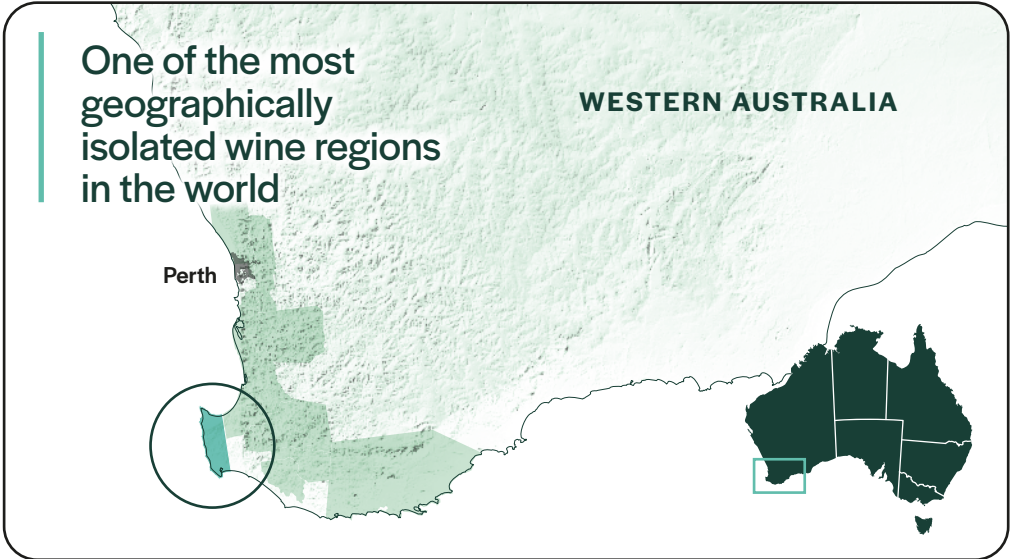


MARGARET RIVER

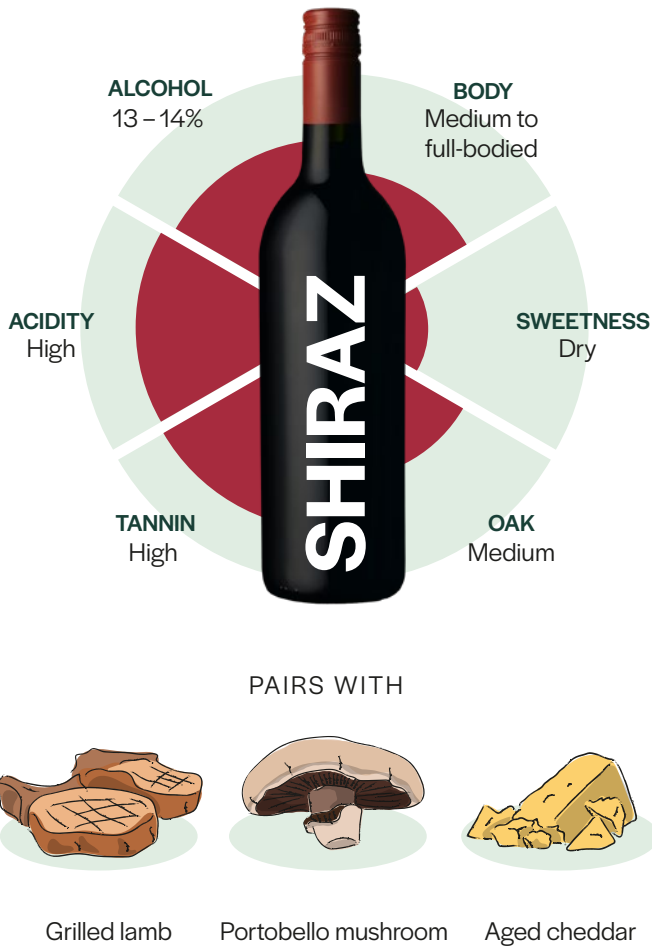

NOTEWORTHY VARIETIES

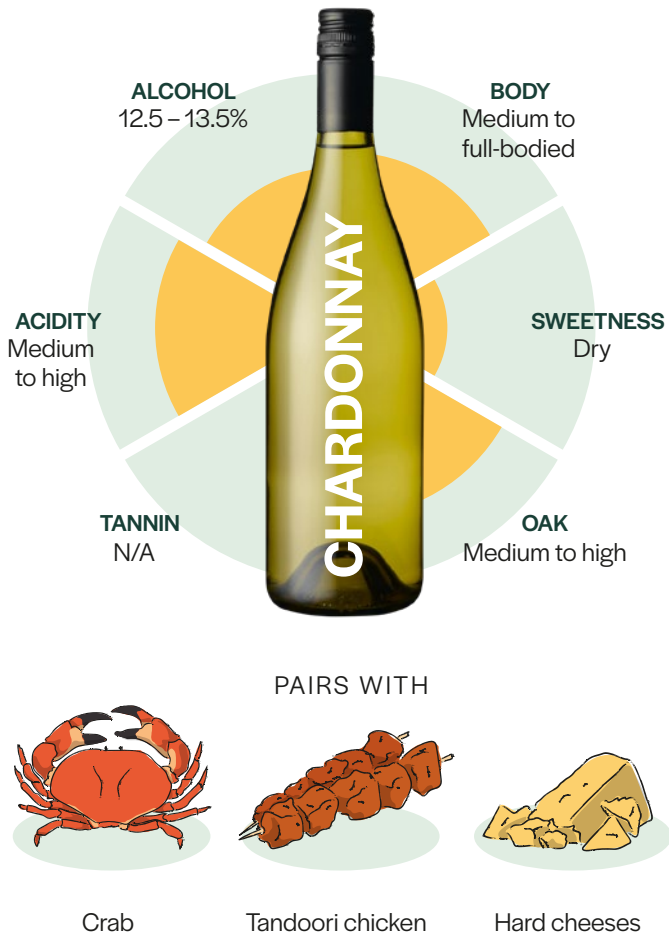
Cabernet Sauvignon

Margaret River Cabernet Sauvignons show an astonishing balance of fruit ripeness, acidity and defined tannin structure, and are suited to long-term cellaring.



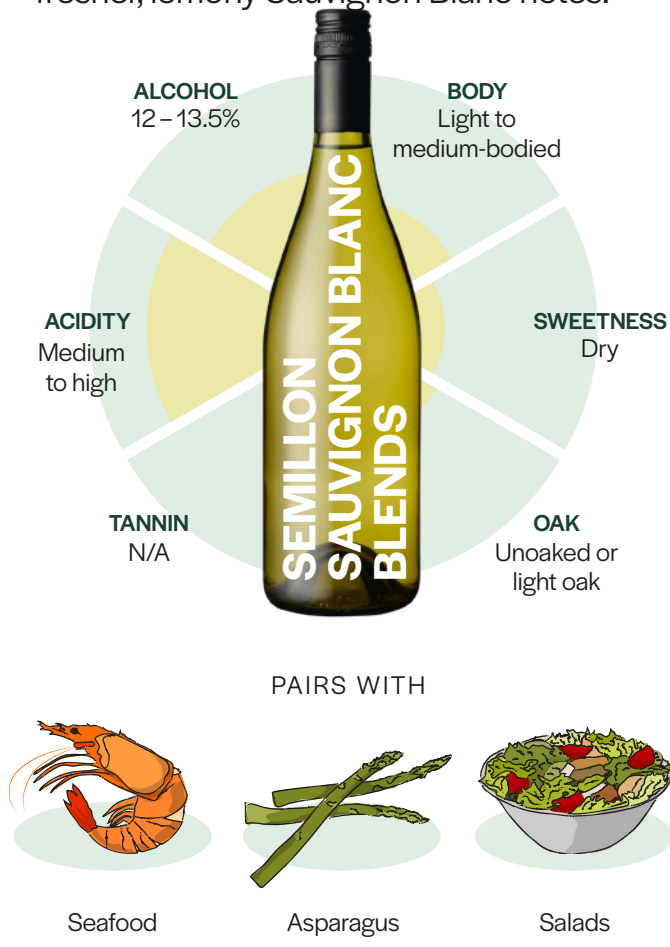
Chardonnay

Margaret River Chardonnay is world class. The wines are concentrated yet refined, with complex flavours and mineral acidity.



Semillon/Sauvignon Blanc blends

This classic white blend is one of Margaret River's signature styles. The two varieties are inherently complementary, with Semillon contributing flavour and roundness to the fresher, lemony Sauvignon Blanc notes.



OCEAN IDENTITY

Margaret River is a peninsula, surrounded on three sides by the ocean. To the north and west it is hugged by the Indian Ocean, whilst the cold Southern Ocean sits to the south. The maritime influence of the oceans is evident in the elegance of the wines, brought about by cooling breezes which help retain delicate aromatics and flavour compounds.
