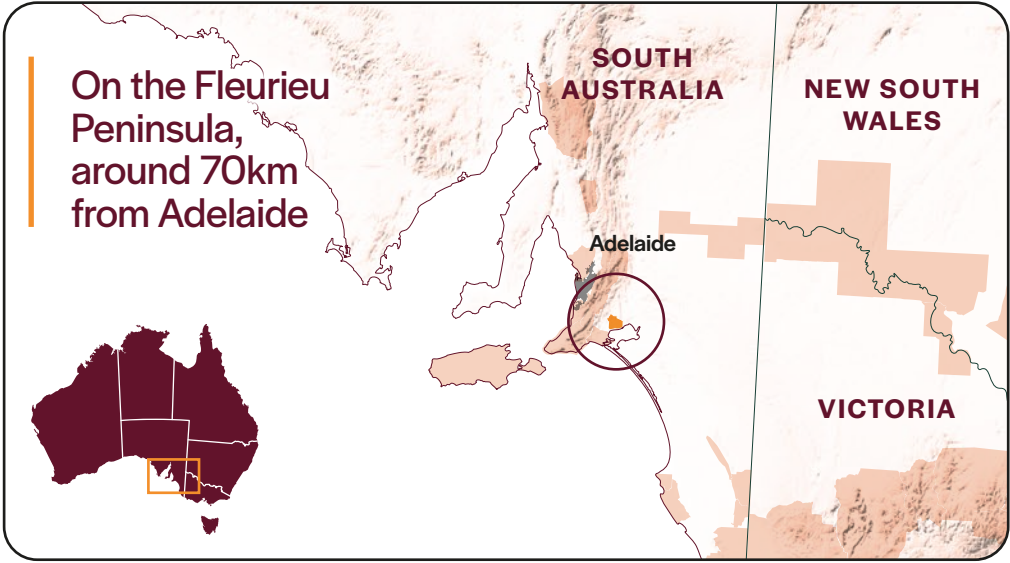


LANGHORNE CREEK

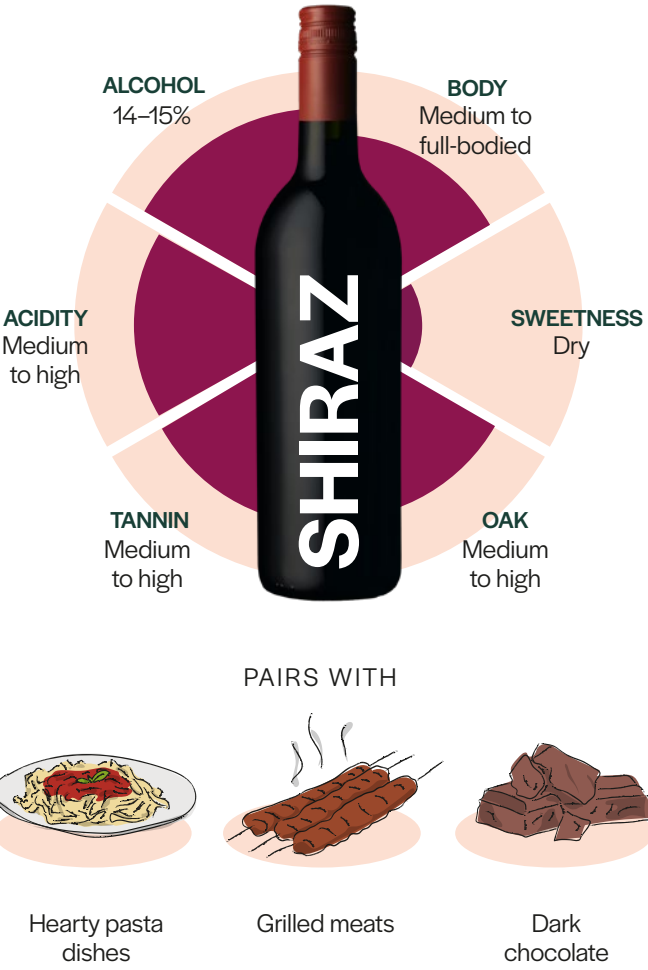

NOTEWORTHY VARIETIES

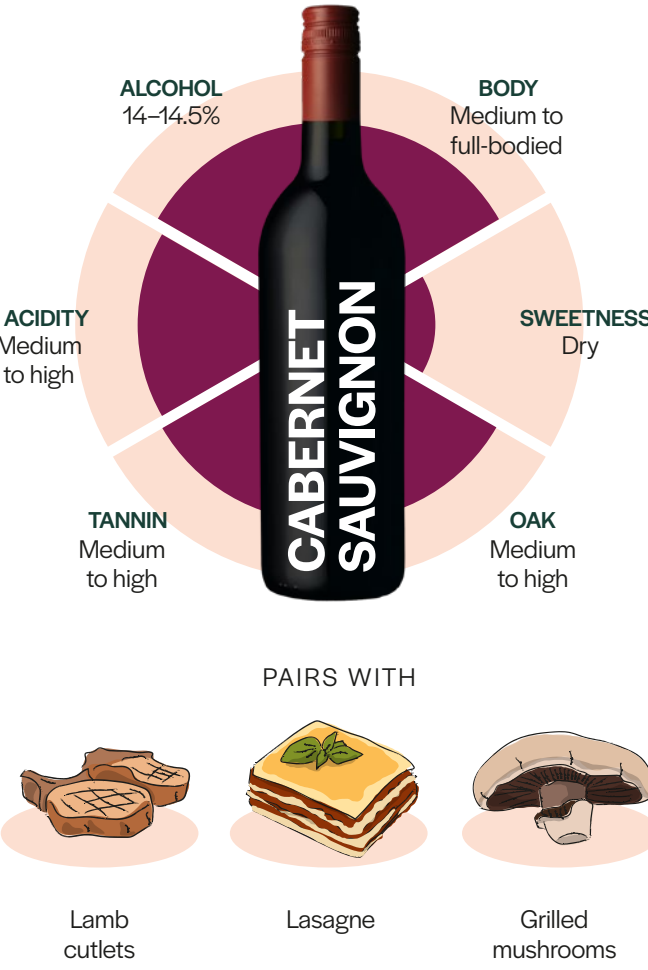
Shiraz

Richly flavoured and generous in style with bold dark fruit characters and refined elements of spice.



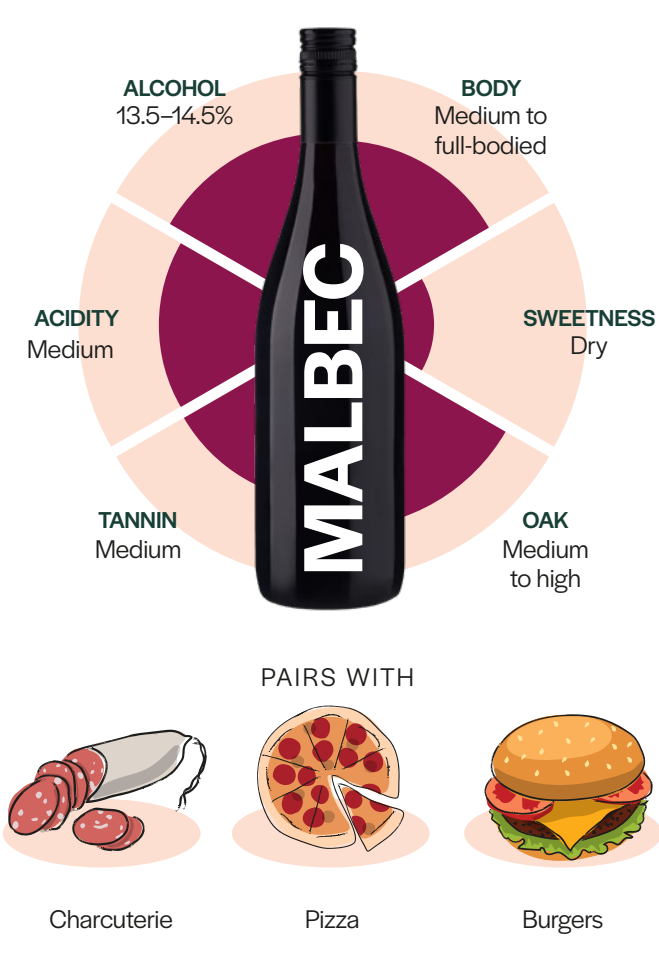
Cabernet Sauvignon

Medium to full-bodied with velvety smooth tannins, juicy fruit-driven flavours and distinctive perfumed aromas of violets.
