The Potts' Catch story

Henry Potts, grandson of Frank Potts, is pictured on the right hand side of the label photo holding a monster Mulloway. Henry was an avid fisherman, with this one caught in nearby Lake Alexandrina where they can grow up to 80kg.



BACKGROUND

Verdelho was among the first varieties planted in Langhorne Creek and still thrives today. Potts' Catch includes Verdelho from our Barrel Shed block planted in 1930.

TASTING NOTES

A crisp white wine with great perfume, jasmine, melon and candied lemon flavours with crisp acidity. Enjoy chilled, naturally a great accompaniment to fish and seafood dishes – especially freshly caught Mulloway!

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

A later vintage than last year, with the majority of harvest being shifted out of peak summer temperatures.

Whites benefited from this especially, producing white wines with lovely fruit and acid balance, with lifted aromatics and elegant but powerful flavours.

WINEMAKING TECHNIQUES

Crushed and chilled before pressing and settling, the old vines are hand-picked and whole bunch pressed. Cool fermentation in stainless steel tank to dryness. A short maturation on light lees before bottling early to maintain freshness.

Vineyards:	Estate Vineyards, including the 1930 Block. Langhorne Creek, South Australia
Alcohol:	13.0% alc/vol
Oak Maturation:	No oak maturation
Cellaring:	Drinking well now until 2027
Food Pairing:	Mulloway, Coorong mullet, seafood or a bean curd laksa.
