

VIEW HILL ROSÉ 2025

VINEYARD

Block: 2A, 2B - View Hill Vineyard

Equal parts Nebbiolo, Syrah and Cabernet Sauvignon, all from the north-western slopes of View Hill. Cones 111, 230 and Mat 10 - chosen for their perfume and fine, chalky tannins. Syrah and Cabernet are set slightly higher and more central across the north-western face. All were hand-picked across late February and early March, chasing freshness, flavour and balance.

VINIFICATION

Each parcel was hand-picked, cooled overnight, and whole-bunch pressed to tank. The next day, the juice was racked and fermented separately. Indigenous yeast ferments took place in old oak barrels and our little egg, with occasional lees stirring to build texture and depth. Once dry, the wines rested on fine lees before being blended in May and bottled in late September 2025 - unfinned and with minimal filtration.

VINTAGE

A dream season for Rosé - solid fruit set, good canopy balance and a clean run to harvest. The tail end of vintage was dry and warm, bringing even ripening and no disease pressure. Careful hand-thinning kept things in check, letting the fruit come in bright, healthy and full of flavour. 2025 was a good one.

TASTING NOTE

This rosé? A mood. Deep and bright, with berries, rosehips and a fine thread of savoury amaro. Dense, juicy and textural - finishing long with touch of Nebbiolo grip. Made for flavour and texture, not the tick-box pursuit of paleness.
