

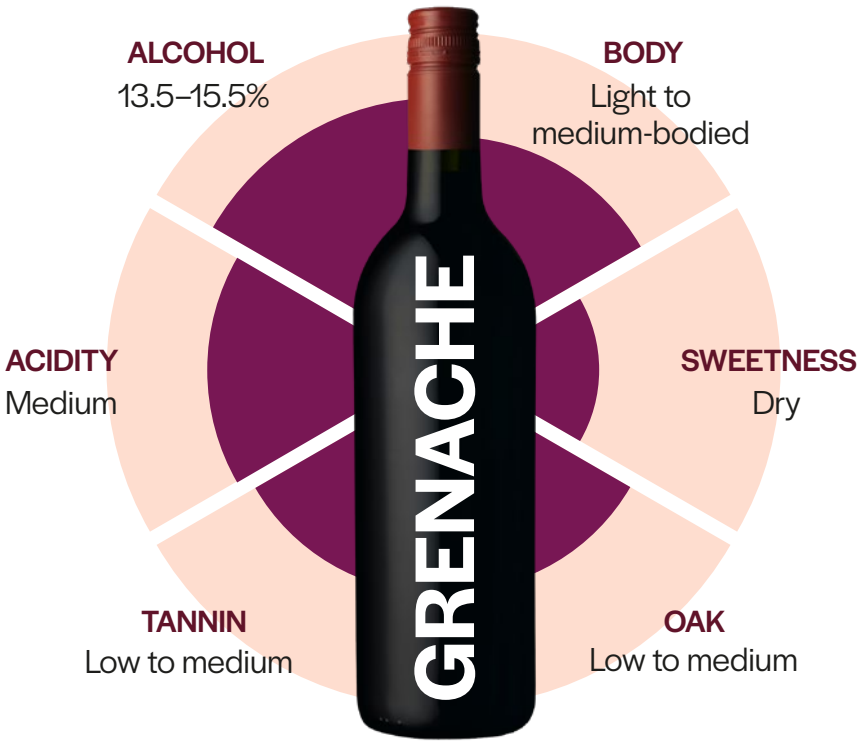

REBIRTH OF A CLASSIC

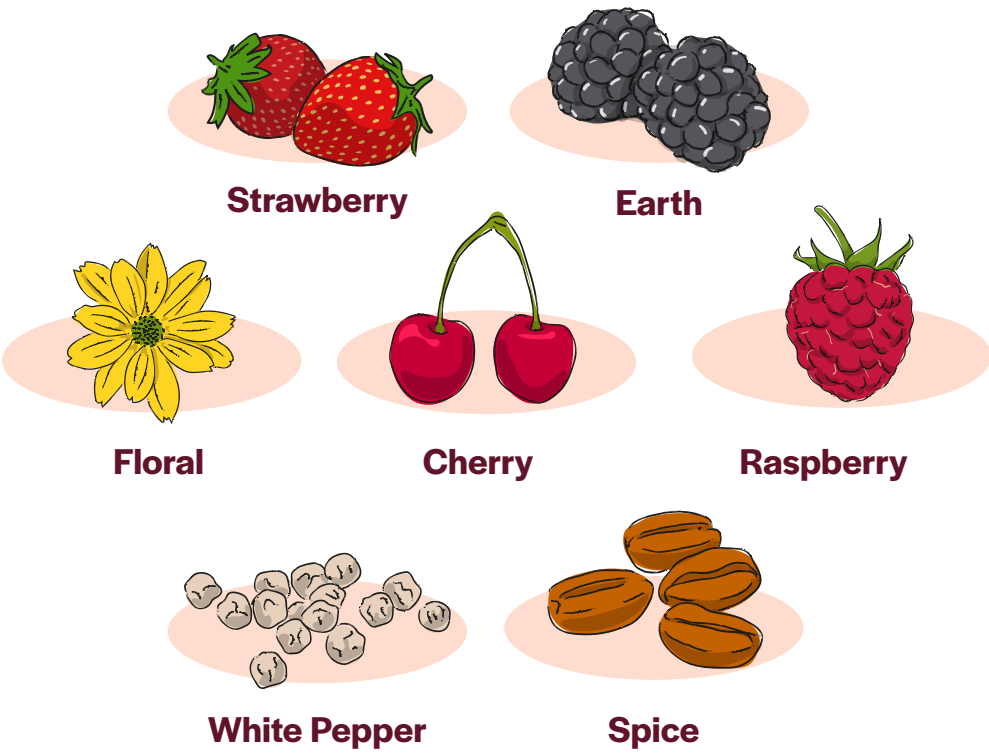
Grenache is sometimes referred to as ‘warm climate Pinot Noir’. Its skill is in making lighter-coloured, perfumed, elegant red wines, not lacking flavour, but with freshness, vibrant fruit and balanced structure. The result is supple, elegant reds that are highly food compatible and very drinkable.

These blends are typically fuller bodied and more intense than varietal Grenache, with Shiraz adding fruit richness and weight and Mourvedre giving savoury spice notes and grainy tannins.
