Tradition

The naming of Portia Valley Wines is representative of Chris Grigoriou's family history in winemaking. It's a combination of his mother's name, Portia, and the location of the first vineyard where she spent long days working at the top of Monash Valley, which overlooked the region and township.



1. HARVEST

Our Grapes are carefully selected and harvested to maximise quality and flavour.



2. CRUSH

Fruit is transported to our Barossa winery to be crushed.



3. FERMENT

Our dedicated head winemaker oversees the transformation of grape juice into high quality wine.



4. BOTTLE

Wine is then bottled in our state-of-the-art bottling facility.



5. SHIP

Our experienced export and logistics team freight wine globally.



6. ENJOY

Vineyards

Portia Valley Wines owns and operates over 100 acres of vineyards in the Riverland wine region of South Australia. The vineyards are Australian Certified Organic and were planted between 1990-2005.

The majority of vines were planted on their own roots with a diverse range of clone stock and varieties used. This includes Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot and Chardonnay.

We also source high quality fruit from McLaren Vale, Barossa Valley, Coonawarra and the Clare Valley.



Australian Certified Organic



Our vineyards are certified organic (Producer Number 10936). Wines made from organic grapes are made to a strict set of winemaking procedures that comply with the International “**IFOAM and USDA-NOP**” organic standard.

The process is audited annually, followed by regular testing by our certifying body: Australian Certified Organic Pty Ltd.

Our Family Reserve collection is the culmination of over 40 years of Grigoriou family winemaking tradition.

Selected vineyards are chosen in Australia's most prized wine regions, including McLaren Vale, Coonawarra and the Clare Valley, to create single site wines of substance and longevity.

Our Family Reserve wines are designed to transport the drinker into the vineyard, and express the true varietal nature of the fruit as well as the unique terroir of each wine.



Grigori Family Reserve

McLaren Vale Shiraz

This wine is rich, deep red in colour with a generous bouquet of pepper and spicy red fruits.

The nose offers a complex bouquet of fruit and spice, with coconut and blackcurrant, enhanced by toasty cigar box nuances produced by oak maturation.

The palate is a highlight of the wine exhibiting bright black cherry, balanced by a leathery earthiness with fine tannins.

The fruit for this wine was harvested from high quality vineyards with careful row selection yielding the best possible parcels for use in this blend.

Full bodied, rich and complex, the colour is deep ruby red.

The aroma is lifted with varietal characters and oaky notes.

Clare Valley Riesling

The cool climate and fertile soils of the Clare Valley are perfectly suited to growing Riesling.

Our Riesling is pale lemon and straw in colour, with notes of lemon, citrus and honeydew on the nose.

The palate is driven by a line of mineral acidity and has a slightly sweet fruit focused finish.
