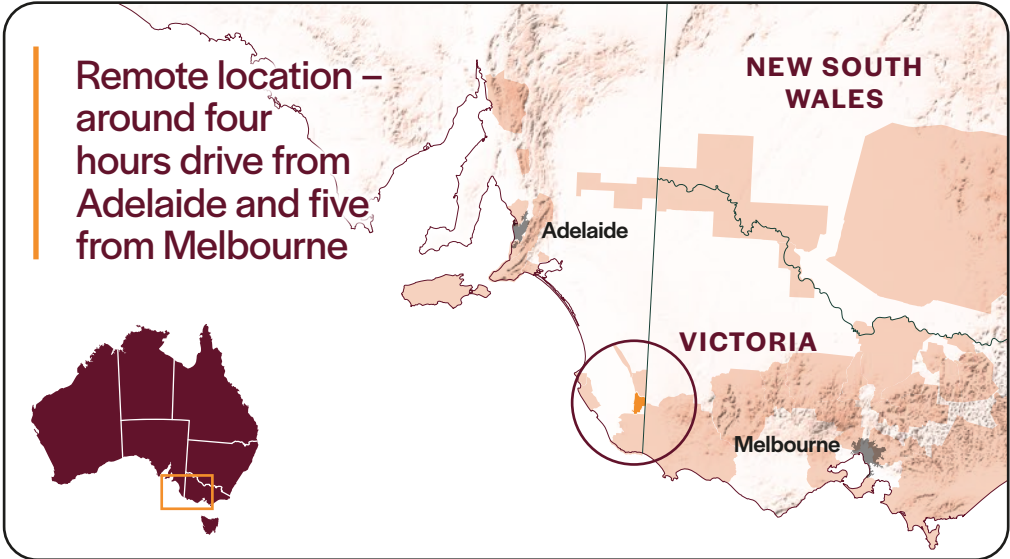


COONAWARRA

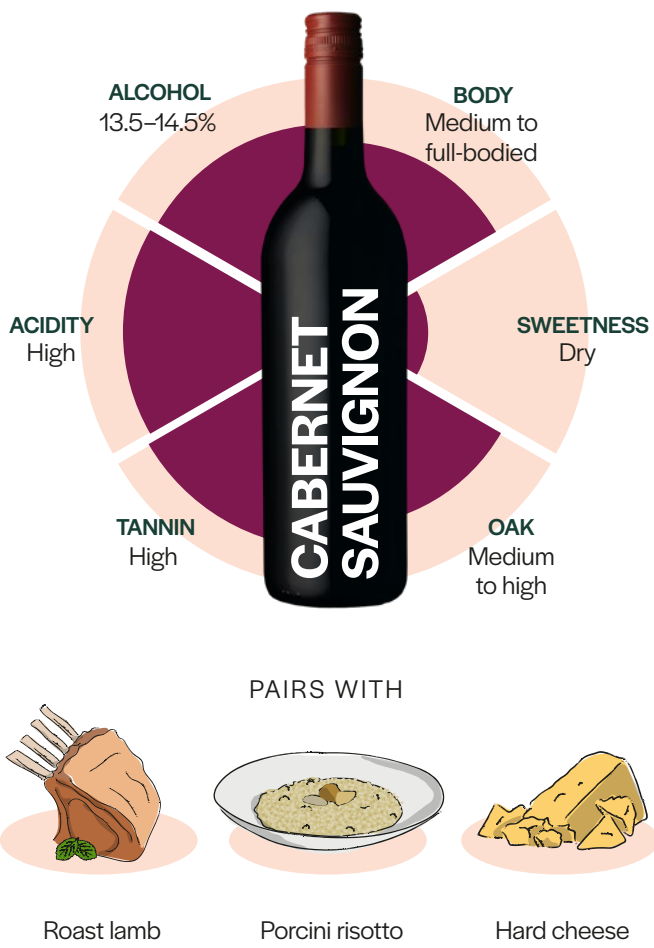

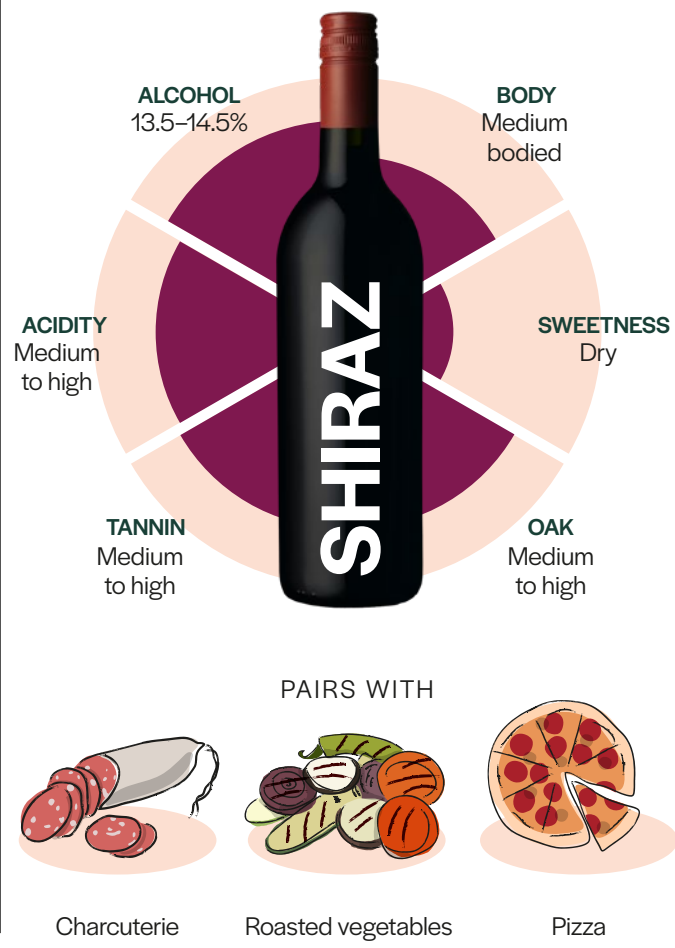
Cabernet Sauvignon

Coonawarra’s undisputed star, with the region’s best Cabernet Sauvignon wines considered some of the world’s purest and finest expressions of the grape.



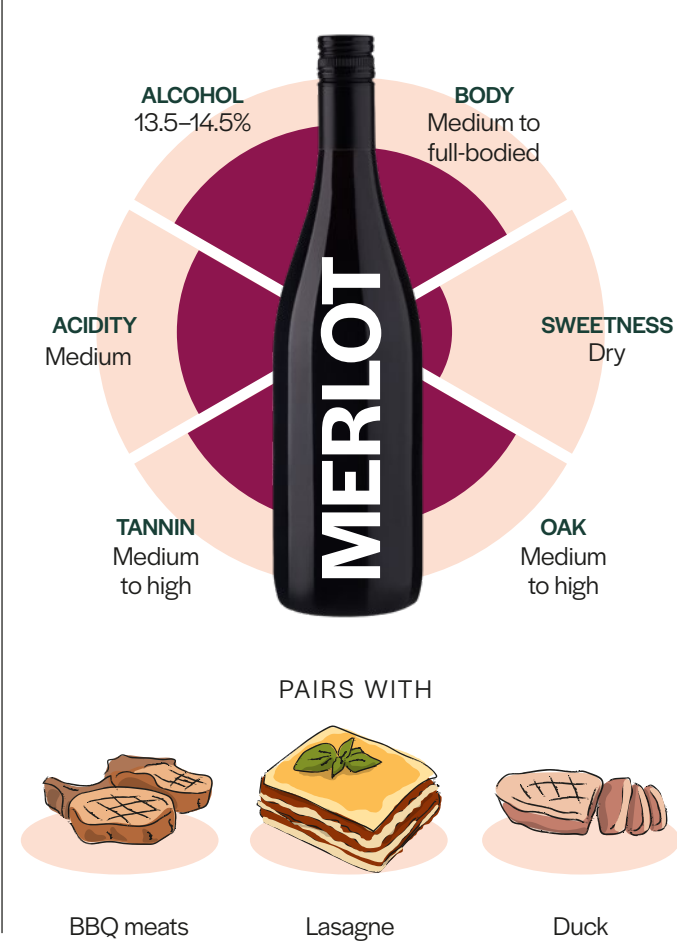
Shiraz

Cooler-climate styles, typically medium bodied and elegant with red and black fruit and spice notes..



Merlot

A variety on the rise, producing some of Australia’s best single-varietal Merlot and is also commonly blended with Cabernet Sauvignon or Shiraz



SOIL

Coonawarra is famous for its red cigar-shaped strip of terra rossa. This iron-rich clay sits atop a ridge of free-draining limestone, below which sits an ancient reservoir of pure water. This tiny stretch of land is among the most valuable patches of earth in the Australian wine community and is part of what makes Coonawarra so special.
