

MORNINGTON PENINSULA

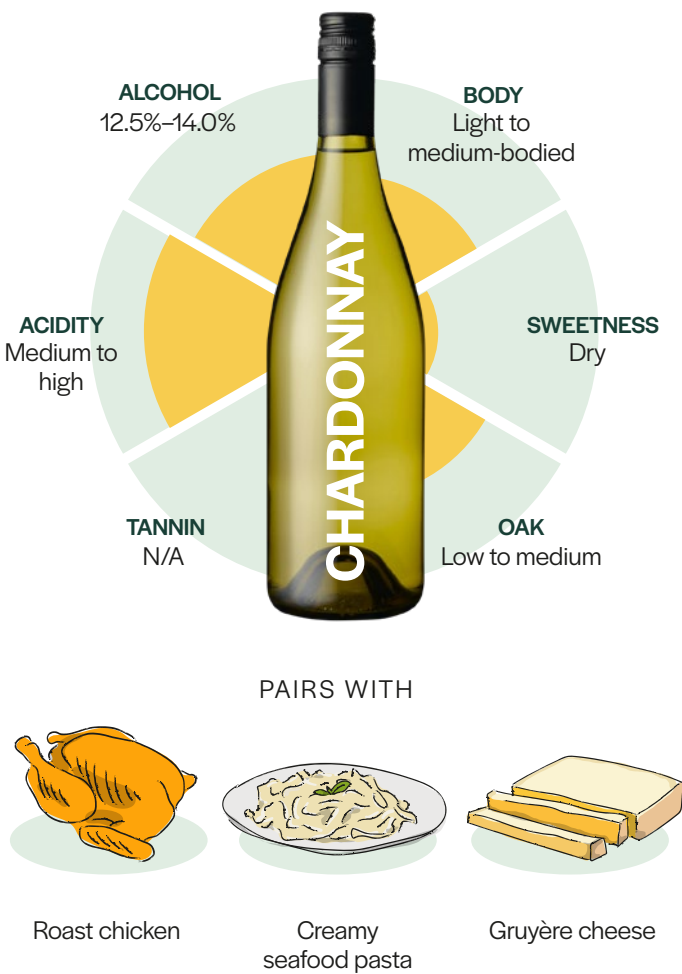

NOTEWORTHY VARIETIES

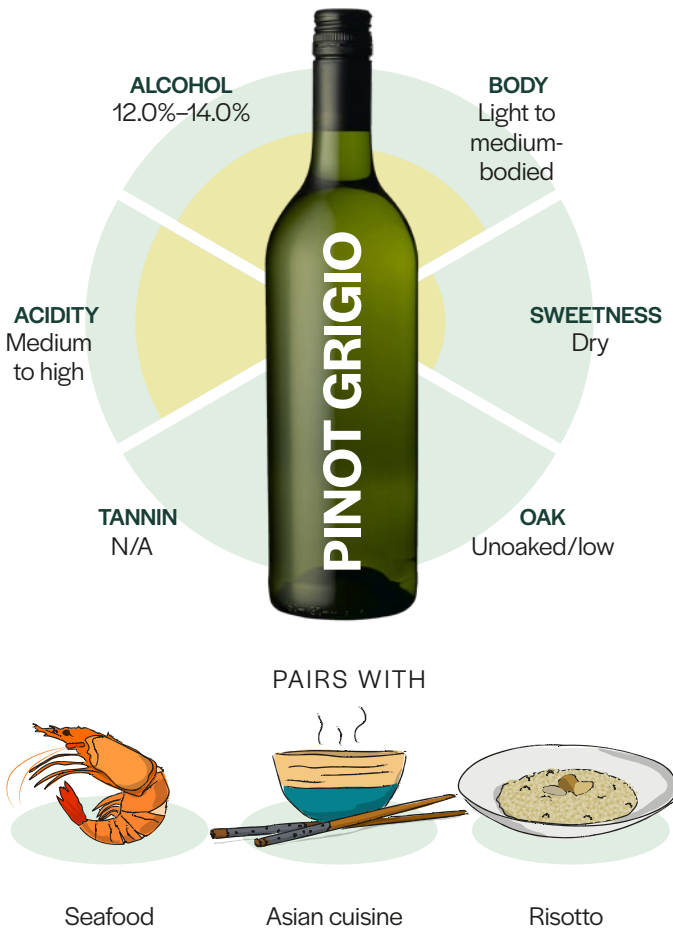
Chardonnay

Typically medium bodied with delicate flavours of melon, white peach, citrus and fig complemented by a soft, creamy texture.



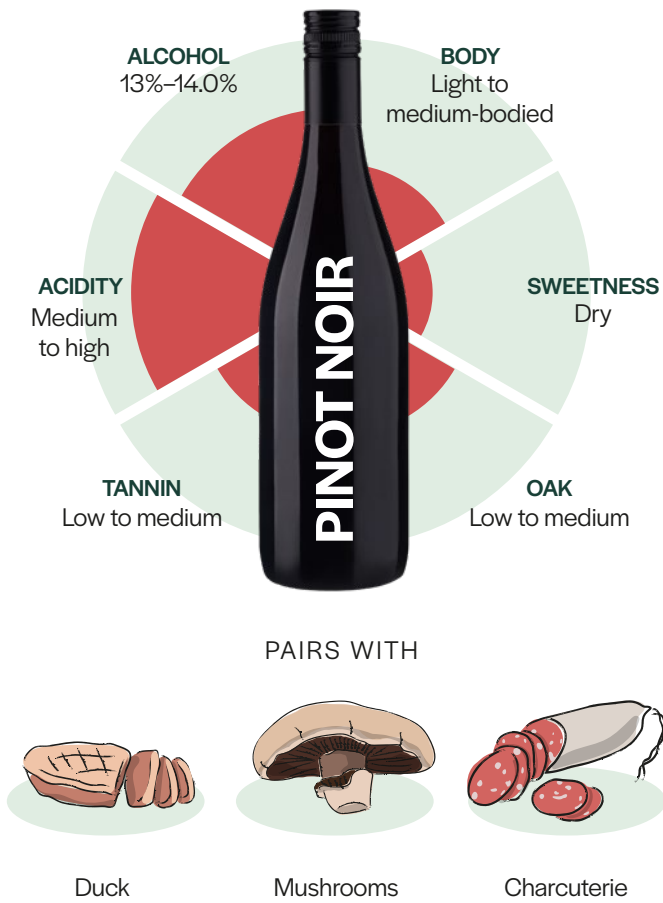
Pinot Grigio

Pinot Grigio styles are light to medium-bodied with vibrant stone fruit flavours. Pinot Gris styles tend to be fuller in body with riper, spicy flavours.



Pinot Noir

Light to medium-bodied with delicate cherry and strawberry fruit notes, vibrant acidity and soft tannins.



MAKING WAVES

Around 200 small-scale vineyards are located in Mornington Peninsula, many of which are family-run. With its cool and maritime influence, Mornington is a Pinot Noir paradise. It is also known for its top-quality Chardonnay and Pinot Gris/Grigio, as well as a range of other varieties including Shiraz, Sauvignon Blanc, Gamay and Tempranillo.
