Tasmania is an island state sitting 240km south of the Australian mainland.



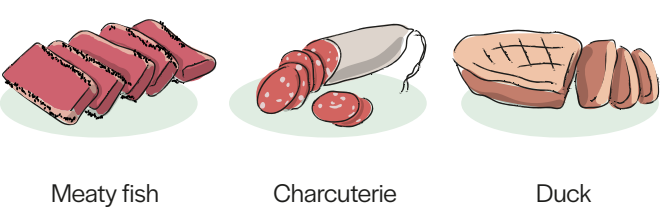
NOTEWORTHY VARIETIES

Typically delicate, fragrant and aromatic with classic strawberry and red cherry fruit flavours.

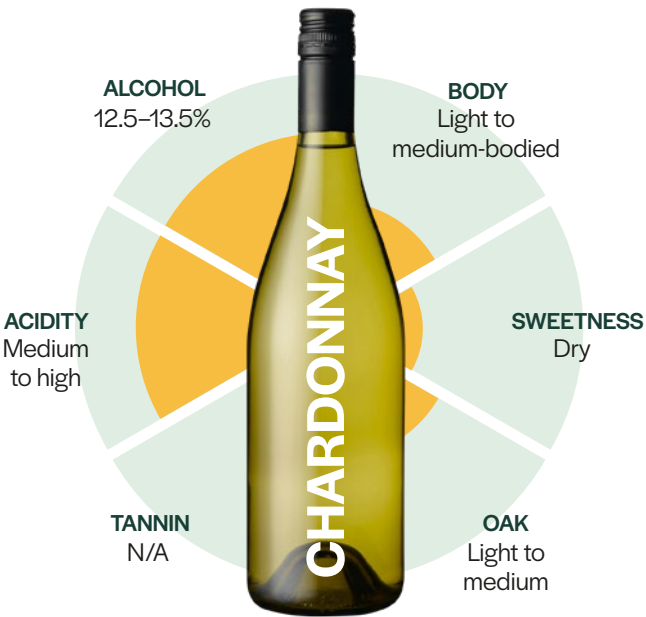

Typically medium-bodied, with vibrant acidity and crisp apple and pear flavours that rival the finest cool-climate examples.

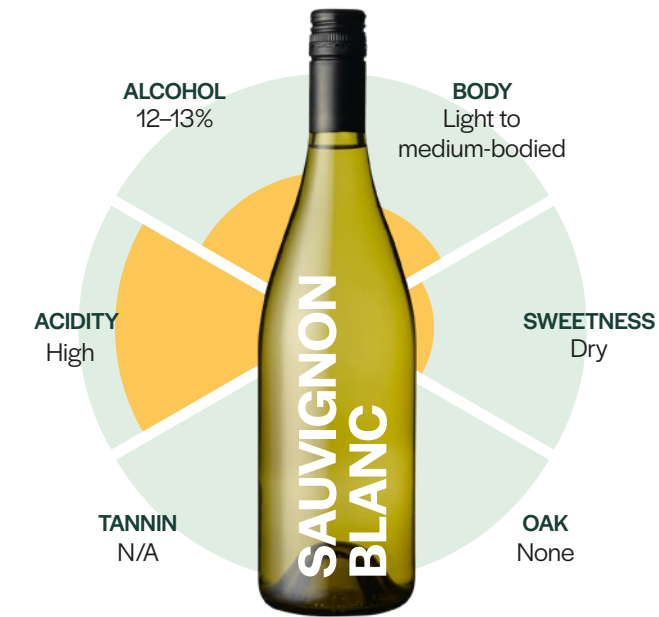


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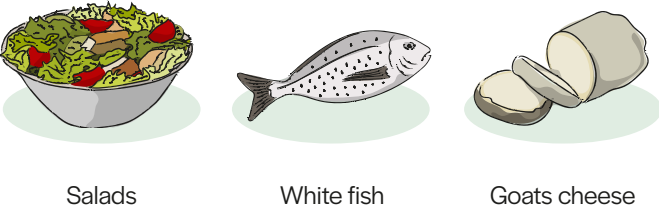


Sauvignon Blanc
