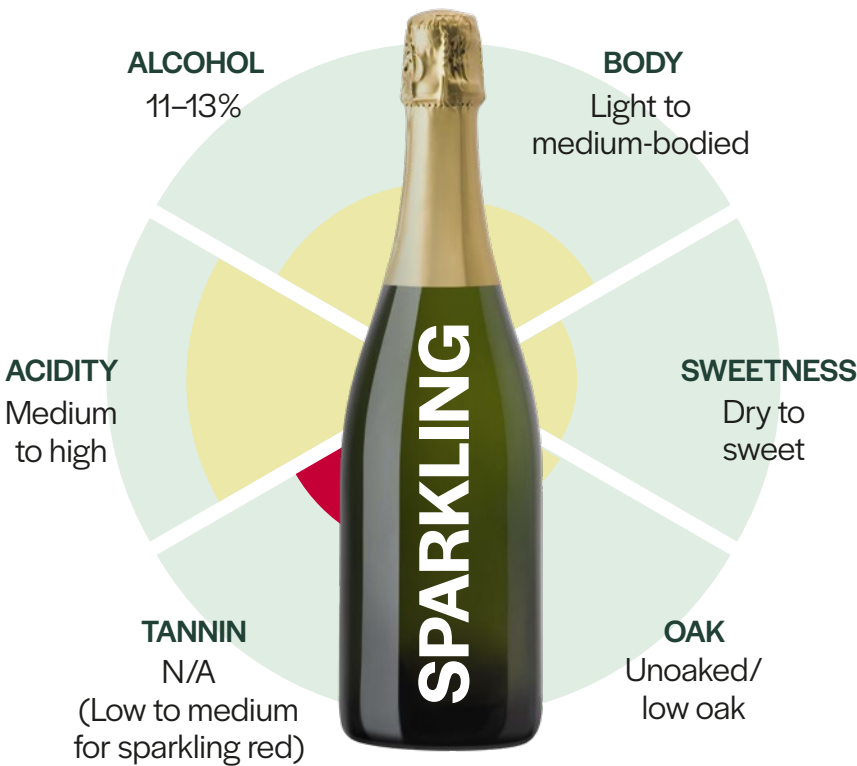


SPARKLING WINES

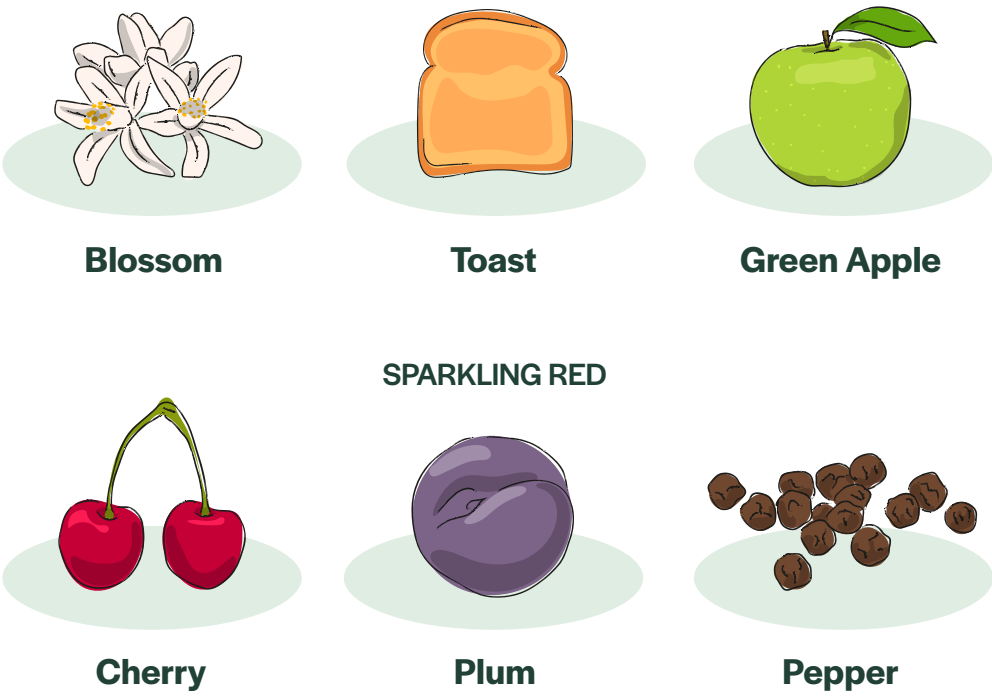

SPARKLING VARIETIES

Most Australian sparkling wine consists of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir grapes, with the most common style a blend of the two. Sparkling wine blends that include red varieties such as Pinot Noir or Pinot Meunier tend to be more full-bodied and show more delicate red fruit notes than those made from just Chardonnay which typically focus more on lemon and apple fruit, along with some floral notes.
