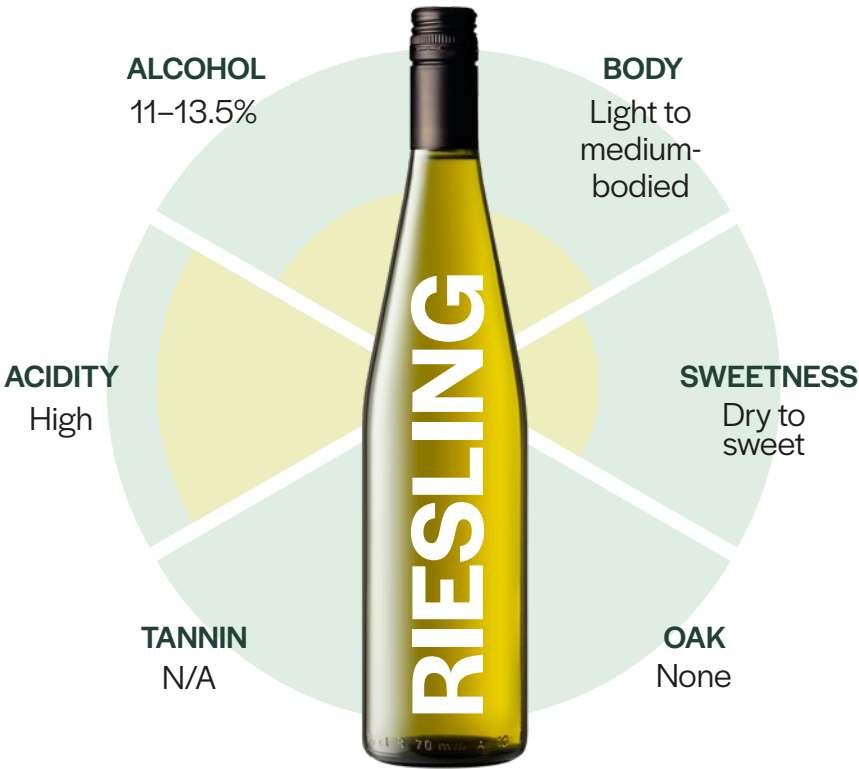


RIESLING

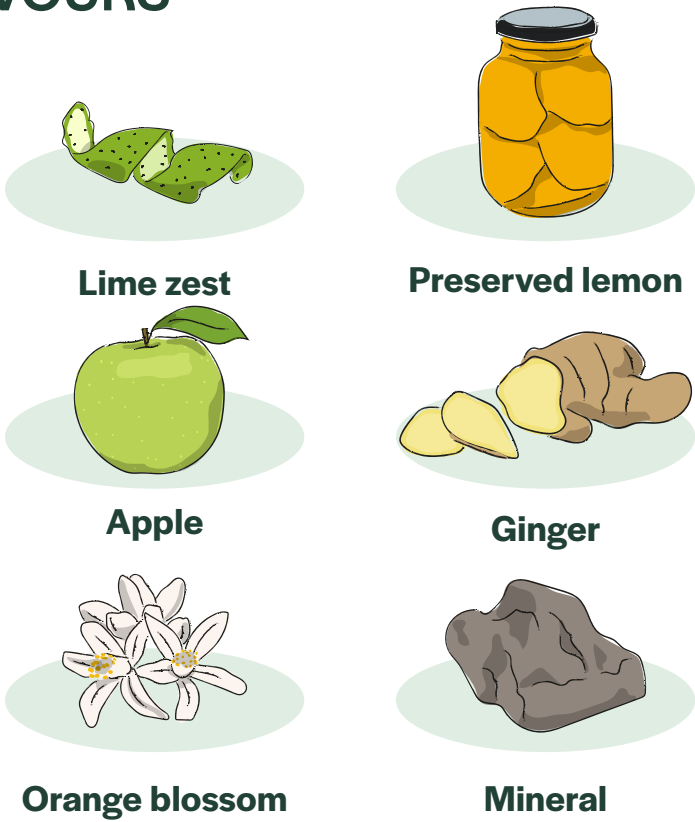

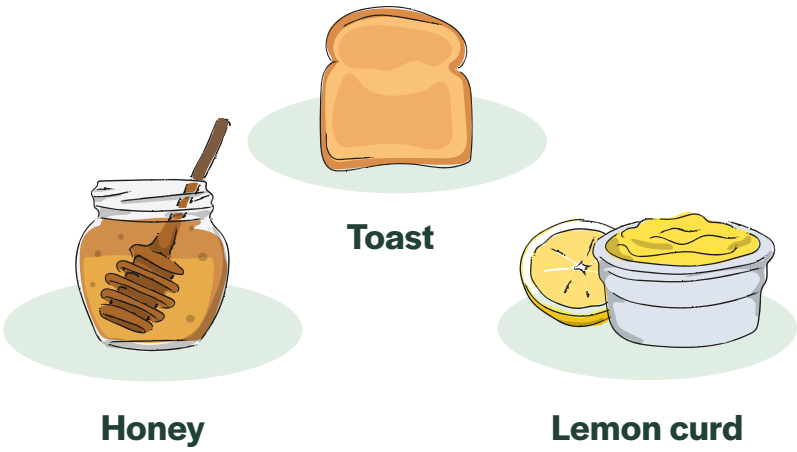

COMPLEXITY WITH AGE

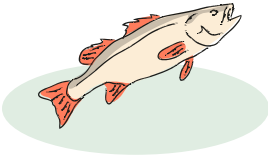

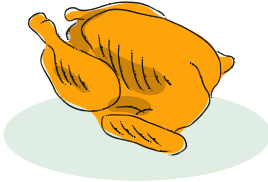

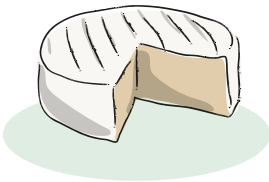
